Heritage Inventory History of Site: Point of Darebin Creek and entrance to the City of Melbourne. The site forms part of the Turnpike Rd, which was the original crossing point of Darebin Creek. The bridge and Old Heidleberg Road were established in about 1840. The bridge had been sold by the late 1860s.
