Interpretation of Site	Site originally used for agricultural purposes in late 19th century, followed by pastoral activities such as farming and orchards. Land is now managed by Parks Victoria with restrcited access.
Archaeological Significance	Possibility for subsurface deposits to exist in relation to the farm house and out buildings and possibly artefacts within the well.
Historical Significance	Some historical significance in connection with first owner J. Smith 1878, and as an early farm site in the area. Local significance.
