History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The New Ada mill was built in 1931-32 as part of the expansion by the Victoria Hardwood Co. A tramway was built north of the Ada No. 2 mill for about 2.5 kilometres, with a short winch hauled incline at the southern end. It appears to have escaped the 1930 fires and closed in 1942, following a short period of salvage work.
