Heritage Inventory Interpretation: Beaconsfield Hotel is on the site of the original (Bowmans Inn 1850's). It was the owner of this hotel who commissioned a road connecting this hotel with the Yarra Track. Hotel then became a major provisioning point. The range of artefacts that are present indicate a prosperous and well stocked business. Further investigation required to clearly establish link.
