With the demise of the Gordon Gold Mining Company in 1939, the mining of kaolin (china-clay) became the main attraction in the division. Kaolin mining was carried out at Mount Egerton by the Victoria Tile Company and the Miss M. Malone Company. Both mines were underground operations, and both companies continued to mine into the fifties with much success, with demand often outstripping supply.
