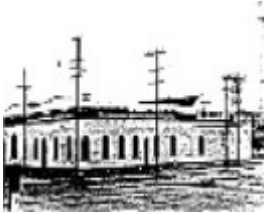

In 1857 the site was occupied by Phoenix Brewery and owned byn & McGill. In 1895 Coghlan amalgamated with Tullock to form& Tulloch Ballarat Brewing Co. Pty. Ltd. At this time, the huge....of hotels to tie trade to the Brewery were bought. In 1911, the company became the Ballarat Brewing Co.Pty.Ltd; in 1935 it became a public company known as Ballarat Brewing Co. Ltd. and in 1958 theassets were sold to Carlton & United Breweries Ltd.; this firm a Hotel Motel directorate.

This building is of interest for the ashlar representation intal courses only. These are bent down to represent voussoirs windows in a Florentine Renaissance manner. The building is detailed and is substantially intact, apart from the painted and infilled carriageways.
