04.02.1873: commenced operating.

25.02.1873: nothing much happening with the float of this company.

10.02.1875: tenders for tribute unsatisfactory; directors have decided to put in a drive south to the level that was lost; contract has been let to E.Cablecott for 5/- per foot.

19.05.1875: tribute given up and work ceased; still pumping pending the formation of a new company.

09.06.1875: plant being auctioned, items include two horizontal engines with 12 inch cylinders, two boilers 20 feet by 5 feet 6 inches and 18 feet by 5 feet, two puddling machines, 170 feet of 10 inch pumps, winding and pumping gear, plus buildings.

11.08.1875: the New North Briton Co. paid £480 for the plant of the Roxburgh Co.
