## History

Cottage built by Edward Edwards, who acquired the land in 1858. Historical records show that a row of cottages ran along the western boundary of this block, while a church was located in the southwest corner. No trace of these was apparent, although the owner related that the church footings were still visible in recent times. The area is now covered by a large shed and by long grass.
