## Physical Description 1

This simple office building was constructed in 1898 for Titheridge, an Estate Agent. In 1900 Titheridge was joined by Mr. C.W. Growcott, and they have conducted business here ever since.

This building is of interest for the large shop window with segmental head, decorative dentillated transom bars to the window and door, and the simple but decorative parapet with segmental arch pediment and flanking scroll. The facade brickwork has been painted, which somewhat detracts from the composition.

There was probably contrasting brick trim to the window and door heads. The facade of this building is a pleasing composition. The interior has been modernised, apart from the wind lock.

This building is in good condition and forms an important streetscape element.
