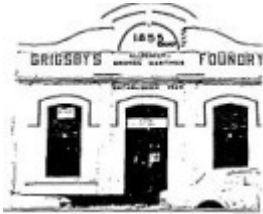

Physical Description 1

This building is of some interest for the simple composition. Pilasters with capitals forming part of the cornice, divide the facade into three sections. The whole is topped by an interesting parapet with segmental arch pediment.

The detailing, however, is somewhat crude, and the effect spoiled by the paintwork. This building, in the Consultant's opinion, did not warrant further investigation.
