## Physical Description 1

This timber house is of interest for its roof line and return verandah. The house design reflects its corner site with a gable surmounting a square projecting bay window and the verandah at 450 to the Weridouree Parade facade. The two projecting gables have decorative hammer, beam "trusses in the gable end. The entrance is marked by a steep pyramidal roof capped by a finial. The verandah has segmental arches surmounted by geometric patterned fretwork..
