Physical Description 1

This fake, timber ashlar fronted house is of. interest for its bay windows elaborate timber verandah. The house would appear to have been constructed in the early 1900' s. The entrance way is marked by a gablet rising from the main roof structure, the wide opening in the verandah and timber doorway with coloured glass side lights. The verandah follows the contours of the bay windows and has three timber balusters flanking a central fretwork panel with an elliptical arch above a series of punched circles. The timber frieze is supported on fanned timber columns and consists of small balusters alternating with elliptical panels.

This building is an important element of the environmental area A.5.1.
