Physical Description 1

The Anglican Church School was established in this brick building in 1857. Later in 1861 the foundation stone for the church was laid and the building commenced operation in 1862. The site of the Anglican Church of England was permanently reserved in 1867.

The church is constructed of locally quarried stone with a slate roof. The rectangular plan is typical of provincial church buildings with a projecting porch to the front facade. A squat belltower incorporates timber ventilators. An early photograph shows a picket fence once surrounded the property, with notable gate posts and finials.
