History

Local knowledge indicates that Harry & Eliza Bastow settled the property in the 1880s and built the current

granite house. After the Bastows, the property was taken over by the Eagles. The current owner indicated that a Brethren sect resided in the area and had houses all over the place. It is unknown at this stage whether the house site was a Brethren house or when it was constructed.
