Interpretation of Site	Site was used as an aiming area for a Rifle Range established in 1900 and used until just prior to WWII. Recreational clubs were formed and members used the site for approximately 40 yesars. Bullet casings, fragments of pottery and glass at the site probably relate to this recreational activity while the small shed likely relates to recent farming activity.

History

Shooting clubs were established in the Korumburra district around 1900. This rifle range was used from this period until pre-WWII (Doug Boston, pers com, 1/3/02).
