Physical Description 1

Consists of 12 structural features associated with the camp ten of which are buildings associated with the 1944 POW camp. There is also a water tank and weir on King Parrot Creek which were constructed for the camp. The majority of the original camp buildings are still in place and the layout of roads and buildings is essentially the same as for the 1944 camp.

The site at Kinglake West, on Camp Road and Whittlesea-Kinglake Road, consists of twelve structural features; ten of which are buildings that date from a 1944 Prisoner of War Camp. There is also a water tank and weir on King Parrot Creek which were constructed for the camp. The majority of the original camp buildings are still in place and the layout of roads and buildings is essentially the same as it was in 1944.
