Broadford WWII Internment Camp No.4; part of site has been used as a gravel dump and parking area. Extant remains consist of a large concrete slab and a concrete water reserve for fire fighting. The water reserve is a square pit 4x4m and approximately 5-6ft deep. Now covered by wire mesh. There is also a rubbish pit, a brick septic tank.

The Broadford Internment Camp No.4, at 430 South Mountain Road, Upper Plenty, dates from the Second World War. The site has few remains consisting only of a large concrete slab and a concrete water reserve for fire fighting. There is also a rubbish pit, a brick septic tank.
