Physical Description 1

Simple rectangular timber framed building on wooden stumps, with horizontal cgi wall cladding and new-looking cgi gable roof. It has a personnel door at each end, one with a wooden landing and stairs. There are eight four-pane windows each side, most of them now blanked off. This building is now used as a store, but looks as though it was originally a dormitory or office. It is similar to some of the WW2 buildings at Block 19, East Bonegilla, but in more authentic condition. Army No.474.

Veterans Description for Public

This building at Bandiana (Army No. 474) is a rectangular timber framed structure on wooden stumps, with horizontal cgi wall cladding and cgi gable roof. It has a personnel door at each end, one with a wooden landing and stairs. There are eight four-pane windows each side, most of them now blanked off. This building is now used as a store, but looks as though it was originally a dormitory or office. It is similar to some of the World War Two buildings at Block 19, East Bonegilla, but in more authentic condition.
