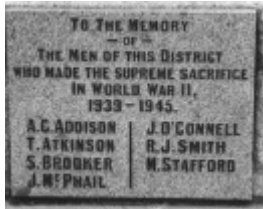

The Neerim District Soldiers Memorial Hospital, located at 27 Main Neerim Road, was built in memory of the district servicemen killed in the Second World War. The building was officially opened by Major General Sir Rohan Delacombe on 15th April 1967.
