#### **Veterans Description for Public**

In 1912 the Commonwealth built an extensive set of timber stables on the former property of the famous Fisher racing family in Maribyrnong. The stables comprised of ancillary buildings and horse exercising yards on the crown of the hill, which still bears the name of Remount Hill. Until their disbandment in 1945, there were two different but related units at Remount Hill; one was the Maribyrnong Remount Depot which was responsible for the purchase, breaking-in, and care of horses for the Australian army, the other was a veterinary hospital. Only the brick stables of the former Fisher stud farm remain.
