The Numurkah War Memorial, located on Tocumwal Road and Saxton Street, commemorates both the First and Second World War. The memorial consists of a grey granite obelisk on a 3-stepped granite base and is topped by a marble statue of Victory. In front of the monument and at its base is a white marble statue of a First World War soldier holding a bronze rifle in the arms reversed position. On the South face of the monument, above a list of soldiers' names, the plaque reads:

"Erected By The Residents Of Numurkah And District To The Memory Of Those Who Paid The Supreme Sacrifice And In Honour Of Those Who Served In The Great War 1914 - 1919"

"Deep Graved In Every British Heart O Never Let Their Names Depart."

On the East face, above a list of Soldiers' names, is a plaque for the Second World War:

"Erected By The Residents Of Numurkah And District To The Memory Of Those Who Paid The Supreme Sacrifice And In Honour Of Those Who Served In The 2nd World War 1939 - 1945 And The Vietnam War

2nd A. I. F."

On the North face the memorial lists the names of Service Women of the Second World War.
