THE EAST GOULBURN MAIN CHANNEL SIPHON AND WEIR FORM A SMALL PART OF A VAST ENGINEERING PROJECT THAT STRETCHES ACROSS NORTHERN VICTORIA. THE CHANNEL IS FED FROM NAGAMBIE WEIR CONSTRUCTED IN 1880S AS ONE OF VICTORIA'S LARGE-SCALE IRRIGATION SCHEMES AND SERVES THE EAST SHEPPARTON IRRIGATION AREA.
