POSSIBLE SITE OF HOUSE RELATED TO BROCK'S FLOUR MILL (C1847-1850S) MAY HAVE BEEN USED AS PART OF FARM ESTATE IN SECOND HALF OF 19TH-C, PLUS EARLY 20TH-C; EG SOFT DRINK BOTTLES. GRAVEL QUARRY APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN USED IN CONTEMPORARY TIMES (C.1940-70).

Homestead 1: 1840s - 1850s

Disused from 1940s.
