Possible mid to late 19th-C building site associated with Brock's Farm and/or early to mid 19th-C house related to Janefield Flour Mill.

POSSIBLE SITE OF HOUSE RELATED TO BROCKS FLOUR MILL (C1847-1850S) MAY HAVE BEEN USED AS PART OF FARM ESTATE IN SECOND HALF OF 19TH-C, PLUS EARLY 20TH-C; EG SOFT DRINK BOTTLES. GRAVEL QUARRY APPEARS TO HAVE BEEN USED IN CONTEMPORARY TIMES (C.1940-70).
