Significant as it demonstrates early rural land use in the Lara area. Its condition is also good as it has the potential to inform and educate on rural practices and development in Lara.

Interpretation of Site	Remains of a bluestone/brick cottage of which the foundation stones are in situ, adjacent to a row of peppercorn trees. Site contains two wells; an older bluestone well and a brick-lined domed well. The areas of cement are possibly a later addition either a storage shed or a dairy. Bricks have been re-used to create water trough attached to a corrugated iron trough. A corrugated iron shed is also located to the west and a later rural addition.
