Lot 1 - Farm established by John Rankin. 1868 - Transfer to Martin Bailey & descendants. 1929 - Transfer to Wilfred Henry Johnston & descendants. Lot 2 - Crown grant to Michael Loeman. 1901 - Transfer to Wilfred Henry Johnston. 1961/3 - Both titles purchased by current owners.
