Low - no associated historical information has been located and there are no associated artefacts or other features.

Interpretation of Site	Associated with gold mining activities in the Panton Hill area. Lack of associated artefacts and documentary information makes it impossible to provide a date for this site. However, gold mining began in the area in 1855 and continued into the twentieth century. It is possible that this shaft was excavated during the 20th century by an individual prospector.

History

Unknown. Panton Hill was originally part of the Caledonia Goldfield, which was first rushed in 1855. Most workings were alluvial, although some deeper quartz mining did take place. Most runs were quickly exhausted, but limited mining continued in the area into the twentieth century.
