Statement of Significance

Updated as a result of the Outer Western Metro Project byContext.

Interpretation of Site	The site contains a section of the original cobbled surface of 'Middle Road', the course of which has now been replaced by the 'Wellness Trail' cycle path.
Archaeological Significance	The road has a low potential for the retention of stratified archaeological deposits within or beneath its cobbled surface. The good condition of this exposed section raises the probability that the road may survive below the ground surface at other places along its previous route.
Historical Significance	The site is of historical significance in that it preserves a section of the original Middle Road, a relatively rare example of a cobbled roadway in a rural setting. Middle Road represents an early radial route between the urban areas around Melbourne and the surrounding countryside and the spread of improved road construction into rural areas.
