Archaeological Significance The remains of the Outer Circle spur between Fairfield and the APM Mill are still evident. When the rail line once passed through, railway sleepers, railway ballast and some metal fittings are visible. There is an embankment on either side of the rail line built up with railway ballast. An indented area within the embankment has trees growing up and may represent the location of the original platform and station building. This area seems to correspond with the shaded area on the Auction Plan above.
