## Physical Description 1

The former Methodist Church is simple building constructed of brick on bluestone foundations in the Gothic Revival style. It has characteristic form and detailing including a steeply pitched roof framed by parapeted gables, stepped buttresses, and lancet window. Other details include a string course, prominent hood mouldings with bosses and the elaborate west rose window.
