Interpretation of Site

The low number of small artefacts suggest the site was cleared at some stage, probably for laying gravel to form the base of the asphalt. Some remaining brick also indicates demolition and mixing of rubble on site, so there is still potential for further artefacts. The foundations are left in place, as once the bricks and soft mortar were removed, these were probably too difficult to salvage or remove. The cistern was probably abandoned in the 1930's when reticulated water became available.
