## **Memorial Window Description & Emp; History**

Although the guide to the chapel's stained glass suggests that this is a memorial 'to those killed in action in HMAS *Australia*', it seems more likely to be a tribute to all Australian seamen killed in action. This is reinforced with the depiction of *St. Nicholas of Myra*, a Patron saint of sailors, coupled with the Coat of Arms of Australia.
