What is significant?

The Moreton Bay Fig (Ficus macrophylla) at 24 Jessie Street, Coburg is significant.

How is it significant?

The Moreton Bay Fig (*Ficus macrophylla*) has historical and aesthetic significance, as well as rarity value, to the City of Moreland.

Why is it significant?

The Moreton Bay Fig (*Ficus macrophylla*) is historically significant as a remnant landscape feature of the 1859 Moreland Hall grounds. (Criterion A)

The Moreton Bay Fig (*Ficus macrophylla*), particularly of this size, age and quality, is rare within the City of Moreland. (Criterion B) The Moreton Bay Fig (

Ficus macrophylla) has aesthetic value as a high quality and visually strikingtree which occupies a large portion of the landscape. (Criterion E)
