

What is significant?

The house at 19 Gladstone Street, Moonee Ponds, built in 1930 for Eric Burgess, is significant.

How is it significant?

The house at 19 Gladstone Street, Moonee Ponds is of local aesthetic significance to the City of Moonee Valley.

Why is it significant?

Aesthetically, it is significant as a representative small suburban villa of its period exploiting the popular Mediterranean theme of the day. (Criterion E)

A representative inter-war Mediterranean style villa with rough cast cement walls relieved by patterned clinker bricks, cabled columns in the Spanish mode, and having an arcaded porch, shingled gable end and terra cotta tiled roof with parapet.

Condition: Sound. Integrity: High, later tiled facings to porch floor and possible later balustrade, garden sympathetic.
