Architecturally, a well preserved example of a typical Queen Anne villa type which is enhanced by its elevated corner siting; metropolitan importance. Historically, little is known of the Villani family.

Physical Description 1

A Queen Anne styled red brick and stucco villa with corner turrett, truss gabled wings, Marseilles pattern tiles and distinctive timber frieze work to the return verandah. Remnants of early shrub planting exist around the house perimeter. Generally original except for the fence.

On an elevated corner site but later than most houses in the street and differing in its scale and detached siting.

The house resembles Queen Anne villas at 59 Lincoln Road (c1909) and 22 Leslie Road (c1908).
