Architecturally, a large example of a typical suburban villa form, in this case enhanced by being well preserved and part of an important streetscape: of regional importance.

Historically, a variation on the typically more modest investments made by local residents of which little is known made in this case.

Physical Description 1

A large Italianate styled stuccoed two-storey residence with a two-level cast-iron verandah, hipped and slated roof and an iron palisade fence at the frontage. The windows are paired and deeply set and the entry is afforded from the side verandah. Most of the terracotta chimney pots have survived and the landscaping is empathetic to the period.

Integrity

Generally original; colours sympathetic.

Physical Description 2

Paired with 38 Wellington Street and the Church Street group, the assembly has many common characteristics and provide a focus for this part of an important streetscape.
