Architecturally, a typical near original Queen Anne domestic form, but distinguished by its tower, details and corner siting: of regional importance.

Historically, with adjoining Queen Anne styled villas, evocative of middle class Edwardian subdivision in Essendon: of local importance.

An almost symmetrical arrangement of two adverse gabled wings attached to a main high hipped roof (Marseilles tiles) with a linking verandah with is distinguished by a low, hipped roof tower. Face red brick and sympathetically painted rough-cast and smooth stucco are the main materials. Details such as the plant motif a set within panels on the tower; the asymmetrical entrance door and side-light arrangement; associated onion-shaped elements to the verandah frieze; and the brick dribbles on the tapered, stuccoed chimneys, give this house a special character.

Some garden elements have survived.

Generally complete except for replacement of the presumed picket fence.

Contributive to the Riversview Est. Precinct particularly as a corner element.
