History

The site looks to date from the early 20th century and is possibly related to timber getting activities. There is a lack of artefacts scattered around suggesting that the place was not a domestic site. A number of early plantings including Hawthorne hedges and pine are present. There are a number of tree aged stumps located at the rear of the property and the owner has reported finding a bogre wheel.
