"Ascog" is locally important as a substantial late Victorian villa residence recalling Caulfield's role as a location for Melbourne's gentry in the years immediately prior to the depression of the early 1890's. Its importance is compromised by the changes sustained over the years.

Representative asymmetrical two storeyed overpainted brick villa with reconstructed two storeyed verandah, cement tile roof and faceted wing. Openings are round and segmental arched with lancet and segmental drip moulds and foliated bosses.
