Physical Description 1

St Margaret Mary's is a substantial interwar Gothic Church constructed of red brick with cement dressings, facing Mitchell Street. The church is complemented by an original and render fence. To the east is a Victorian Italianate

style residence, asymmetrical in plan with a slate roof and chimneys, and to the west is the two storey brick school, which is a two storey building constructed of brick with a hipped tile roof and large multi-paned windows. The gabled brick church hall faces Donald Street. It has buttressed side walls divided into bays containing tall multi-paned timber windows with small six-pane windows in the end walls. The gable ends are half-timbered, jettied on timber brackets.
