What is significant?

The Brunswick North Primary School at Pearson street, on the corner of Albion Street, Brunswick West.

How is it significant?

North Brunswick Primary School at Pearson street, on the corner of Albion Street, Brunswick West is of local historic and aesthetic significance to the City of Moreland.

Why is it significant?

Of historic significance for its pioneering work in education, especially in the area of integrated studies and mathematics. Also for its continuing use as a primary school since 1909, and since its establishment on this site in 1923. (AHC Criterion A.4)

Of aesthetic significance, as a good and typical example of a substantial inter-war primary school in the City of Moreland. (AHC Criterion F.1)

Physical Description 1

Brunswick North Primary School is a typical red brick and stucco inter-war primary school with a hipped terracotta tiled roof. Chimneys are painted stucco with red brick caps and what appears to be a small bellcote in the centre of the ridge line of the main body of the building. The building is predominantly red brick with a deep painted stucco band from the eave line to the underside of the first floor window sills. Windows to the ground floor are large multi-paned round arches with double-hung sash inserts and windows to the first floor are multi-paned pairs of double hung sashes.
