What is significant?

'Anunaka Mansion', comprising the house constructed c.1945, at 37 Churchill Park Drive, Endeavour Hills.

How is it significant?

'Anunaka Mansion' at 37 Churchill Park Drive, Endeavour Hills is of local aesthetic significance to the City of Casey.

Why is it significant?

Aesthetically, 'Anunaka Mansion' is significant as an unusual example of the eclectic styles of architecture that were favoured during the interwar period and immediately afterwards. (AHC criterion E1)

Anunaka Mansion at 37 Churchill Drive, Endeavour Hills is a two storey clinker brick interwar or immediate postwar house. The style is typical of the eclectic picturesque styles favoured during the period and shows influences of the English Domestic revival style including the steeply pitched gable roof containing attic rooms, multi paned windows, chimneys and use of clinker bricks.
