Last updated on - April 28, 2005

Built in 1859 for Sir William Foster Stawell, the colony's first Attorney-General and later Chief Justice. D'Estaville was designed by the prominent colonial architects Knight & Kerr, the designers of Melbourne's Parliament House, in the Classic Revival style.
