Interpretation of Site	Heritage Inventory Interpretation: Site complex linking Robinvale when the Murray River near Euston, mostly pre-dating existing bridge (1928). Complex consists of a raised embankment, which carries the road and bridge sites across deeper washways on the floodplain floor. Possibly associated with other activity areas on the floodplain, including charcoal burning sites and buildings formerly located adjacent to Moore Street (at the east end), where the council depot is currently located.
