### Statement of Significance

Last updated on - January 10, 2008

These two cottages were erected in the 1850s, No 8 being constructed in 1856 by Thomas Philpin, Landing Waiter in the Customs Office as his residence, whilst No 6 was constructed in 1859 by S J Bayly as a Solicitor's Office. These simple, symmetrical cottages feature a central doorway and twelve pane sashes to either side. The roofs are hipped in form and the buildings typify the early Colonial cottages which characterise Port Fairy.
