The summer residence of Judge Fellows MLA built c.1860 of limestone block, rendered, with a slate roof, french windows opening on to a verandah around three sides with simple timber trim and balustrading supporting louvered shutters on the west; some alterations to eastern bay and outhouse; brick stables of probably later date included, but minor additions and alterations excepted.
