

The significance of Coolart Lagoon and Wetlands is as follows:

(1) Aesthetic Value

The key aesthetic features of Coolart include the Homestead, the earlier "Barracks" building, their outbuildings, the gardens, the Lagoon, the Wetlands, the woodlands bordering Merricks Creek and the remnant of the original Coolart farm. The old tree lined drive (Luxton Drive, the former entrance) is adjacent to the Coolart property and is included in the citation.

The aesthetic attributes of the Lagoon and Wetlands are of Regional significance.

(2) Historical Value

Coolart is of Regional Significance as an example of the history of land alienation and subdivision practices, and of human manipulation of the landscape (Coolart Committee of Management, 1990).

(3) Scientific Value

The scientific value of Coolart, as represented by its fauna and its original and man-made "natural" elements is of State Significance.

(4) Social Value

The purpose served by Coolart today is as a valuable field education resource.

The social value of Coolart is of Regional Significance.

LOCATION:

Coolart Reserve is in Lord Somers Road, Somers, on the south eastern Mornington Peninsula between Balnarring and Somers on Western Port. It is about 75 kilometres by road from the City of Melbourne.

Coolart is bounded to the north by freehold land, to the west by Balnarring Beach Road, to the south by Merricks Creek and to the east by Lord Somers Road and the Somers Children's Camp.

The whole of the Coolart Reserve.

While this citation deals primarily with the Lagoon and Wetlands, the education and conservation role of Coolart relates to the whole site, which justifies the choice of boundary.
