The narrow gorge has been cut in sandstone. A well formed, winding road runs through it from the Bass River to Glen Forbes South and Bass Hill. Remnants of a wet sclerophyll forest remain along the creek line, upper slopes are cleared, but scattered remnants of Messmate, *E. obliqua*, forest still stand.

When travelling down this gorge the focal view is impressive - Western Port framed by the sides of the gorge.
