Contribution to the landscape

One of the most significant properties in Victoria, 'Bontharambo' was settled in 1838 with extensive surrounding parklands, including an impressive collection of four Kurrajongs (*Brachychiton populneus*). The largest of these occurs beside the drive near the east side of the house. It is an outstanding specimen with a wide spreading canopy, globular crown and large trunk.
