## Physical Description 1

An interwargable-frontedbungalow constructed of red brick with roughcast render detail painted white. It has a projecting gabled porch supported on square rendered columns with a brick balustrade. There are brick and render chimneys, one with a terracotta pot. Windows are 'boxed' and include a triple casement with coloured toplights and shingles, and paired double hung sash.
